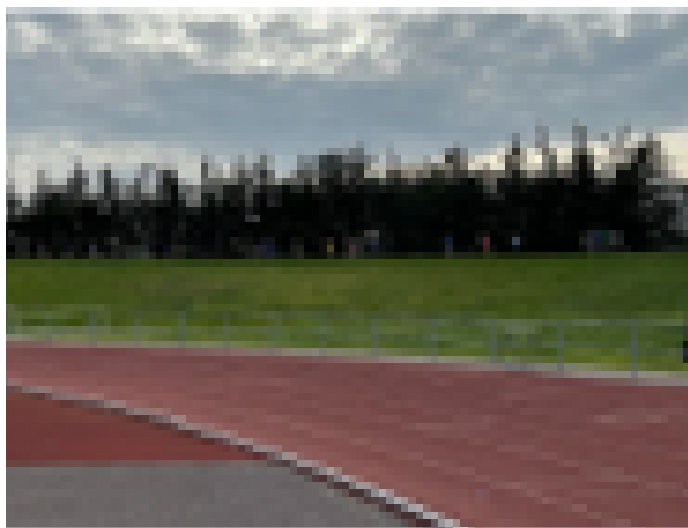


Tag Rugby Development and Tournament

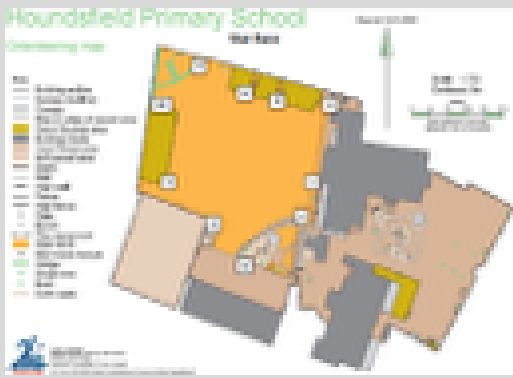
Dance Festival 2025 "One night on Broadway"

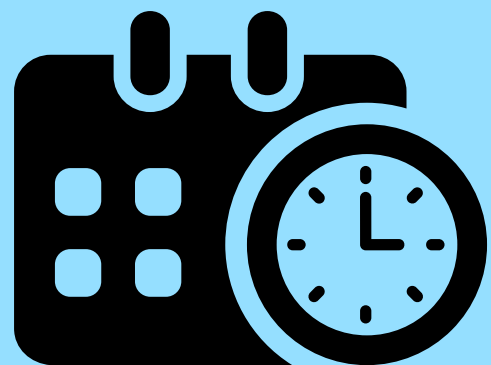
Football knockout competition
