We are very grateful to Lea Valley Academy for allowing us to host in their lovely hall and to the year 7 and 8 pupils that came along to support the children.




YEAR 3/4 TAG RUGBY

YEAR 5&6 TENNIS


We had a very enjoyable afternoon of Mini Orange Tennis in the sun on 24th June!
