The Year 3/4 Quadkids Athletics event was held at Lee Valley Athletics Centre in early May. Teams of 5 girls and 5 boys each sprinted 50 metres, ran 400 metres, threw a vortex and performed a standing Long Jump. Each performance scored points, the faster the run, the longer the jump/ throw, the more points they scored. Their points were then all added together to give a school total.
